

2018 sees the celebration of 100 years of Birmingham Civic Society with an exciting and inclusive public programme of events and activities.

The Birmingham Civic Society was founded by a group of civic-minded individuals on 10 June 1918, in the final months of the First World War. Its primary focus was to influence the postwar regeneration of the city.

In the early years, the Society acquired land to create open spaces on which to establish parks in parts of the city where there was increasing development, such as Northfield and Kings Norton. The Society also made improvements to several parks including Aston, Handsworth and Cannon Hill.

Over the century, the Society campaigned to save a number of historic properties and helped to safeguard the future of The Rep Theatre. It ensured the survival of Birmingham Cathedral's Burne Jones windows by removing them prior to enemy bombardment in the Second World War. In the 1950s, the Society established its popular Blue Plaque scheme, honouring significant people who have lived or worked in the city.

Today the Society has an active and growing membership. It continues to lobby for an improved urban environment and strongly promotes active citizenship. The Next Generation Award encourages young people to play a role in the future

of the city; Renaissance Awards recognise the most successful conservation projects in the city; and Birmingham Trees for Life has planted 70,000 trees so far, but this number continues to increase.

With funding from The Heritage Lottery Fund, Birmingham Civic Society's Centenary programme - 'The City Beautiful' - tells the story of the Society's first 100 years through a number of projects that reflect its widereaching activities and achievements and takes the opportunity to look forward to the next 100. The City Beautiful' will see four new Blue Plagues unveiled in the city, a new series of creative films, a project with young people, a new printed trail, an outdoor display and a lively programme of public events created in partnership with organisations across the city. In collaboration with Birmingham Museums Trust and with assistance from the Limoges Charitable Trust, the Society is supporting the conservation of the statue of Queen Victoria in Victoria Square.

We invite you to join the celebrations this year and help us look forward to many more years of making Birmingham a better place for everyone. ■
