# REVIEW

## THE FRIENDS' VISIT TO THE WINTERBOURNE COLLECTION



A group of Friends visited Winterbourne on a sunny day in July.

After a welcome drink on the terrace we were given a short tour of the house by Collections Officer Henrietta Lockhart who pointed out some of the many treasures including the wonderful portrait of Mrs Nettlefold in the hall.

We then went into buildings at the back of the house not open to the general public when the archives are kept. Here, Henrietta had arranged a selection of items for us to examine. Many concerned the personal life of the Nettlefold family: a wonderful selection of photographs; postcards; diaries and paintings. Some of these showed the connections between the Nettlefolds and other prominent Unitarian families such as the Chamberlains, Kenricks and Strutts. Also on display were the embroidered coat and

accoutrements which Edward Strutt MP wore for Court occasions in the 1850s, and a photograph of a member of the family wearing it as fancy dress in the 1880s. The second selection was part of the archive of the company of Guest, Keen and Nettlefold - usually known as GKN - which has recently been given to Winterbourne. This showed some of the many different types of products made by the company.

We then retraced our steps to the courtyard and looked at a new area recently opened to the public. This contained some interesting plants and an exhibition about the history of Winterbourne's garden. We were then free to have lunch and look around the beautiful gardens to conclude a very interesting visit. ■
